### Visit Guidelines

---

#### **Cost and Materials**

Programs are free of charge and include workshop materials.

#### **Group Eligibility**

Programs serve students from Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. All types of organizations are welcome, including public, private, and parochial schools, after-school programs, and camps.

#### **Capacity**

The Drawing Center can accommodate a maximum of 30 participants during one visit. We require a ratio of one adult for every 10 students under the age of 17.

#### **Length**

Visits are approximately one and a half hours in duration. The first forty-five minutes is an exhibition tour, and the second forty-five minutes is a hands-on activity.

#### **Scheduling**

Groups may visit on Mondays and Tuesdays between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM or Wednesdays between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Alternative times may be considered upon request. Please call at least two weeks in advance to schedule your visit. If you must cancel or reschedule, please notify us at least one day in advance.

#### **Special Needs**

Programs can be adapted to fit most special needs. Please contact the Director of Education and Community Programs to discuss your group's particular needs.

#### **Repeat Visits**

Classes are encouraged to visit more than once over the course of a school year, so that students experience first-hand a variety of exhibitions.

#### **Pre- and Post-Visit Materials**

Pre-visit teaching guides are available to help plan your visit, and include materials such as preparatory discussion topics, hands-on exercises, exhibition information, and travel instructions. Post-visit art exercises and discussion topics are also available for follow-up in the classroom.

#### **In Addition**

Students should not bring schoolbags or any additional materials with them. They must be respectful of other patrons and not block entrances to the galleries. Students may not touch the artwork. Food, drink, and physical activities are not permitted in the galleries.
